THE OAK COLLECTION PART I

Christie's global reputation for presenting the most spectacular single-owner private collections of watches in the world is second to none. It is therefore with immense pride, excitement and anticipation that Christie's Hong Kong now offers in this catalogue truly one of the most remarkable watch collections in private hands. Known only to a select few until 2021, the collection was built discreetly over more than 30 years. Described by its owner as a journey, which continues here with this, the first auction from the collection, pays tribute to the collector's boundless dedication, commitment and perseverance in assembling a virtually unrivalled selection of both historical and contemporary timepieces. These watches celebrate the astounding work of not only the greatest names in established Swiss watch manufacturing, but also showcase the very finest creations of several formidable independent watchmakers working today.

The Oak Collection is an acronym of 'One of a Kind', and a significant number of the watches to be offered here are indeed 'one of a kind'. Such timepieces are the most eagerly pursued by collectors due to their unavailability to all but the most exalted and loyal of a brand's clients. This auction provides collectors, and those individuals for whom only the most exclusive artworks and objects are considered, the singular opportunity to possess watches that will not be seen on any other wrist. Moreover, watches in this extraordinary collection are mostly in truly perfect condition, the majority being either new or virtually unworn and regularly serviced.

The desire by the owner of the Oak Collection to share some of the masterworks of the collection with a wider audience led to a world tour exhibition of 160 watches from the collection in London, between December 2021 and June 2022. Naturally, timepieces by Patek Philippe

dominated, and sections of the travelling exhibition focused upon the 'Calatrava'; Chronographs; Perpetual Calendars; World-Time watches and rare handicrafts. The Patek Philippe part of the collection is also remarkable in containing the largest number of timepieces once owned by the legendary collector Henry Graves Jnr. outside of the Patek Philippe Museum in Geneva.

The collector's significant commitment to contemporary watchmaking and charitable causes is amply demonstrated by the fact that he became one of the most active buyers at several of the the nine biennial 'Only Watch' charity auctions held to date. The collection holds no fewer than 10 unique 'Only Watch' timepieces representing makers such as Kari Voutilainen, H. Moser, Chanel, Hublot and Roger Dubuis.

In the Oak Collection, each and every watch can be considered a highlight. Of course some pieces stand out even among such distinguished company, one of these is a Patek Philippe reference 1436 Rattrapante split-seconds chronograph with black dial, of which only 59 yellow gold examples are known and only a handful of those sporting the ravishing black dial. More diverse highlights are a Breguet triple calendar chronograph once owned by French actor Jean-Paul Belmondo and Jack Brabham's Breguet Type XX chronograph of 1959. Awe-inspiring watches by independent makers include Akrivia's SS AK-06 'Cadran Spéciale Bleu' and Kari Voutilainen's stainless steel GMT 6 for 'Only Watch'.

Globally significant and without doubt in a class of its own, the sale of the Oak Collection Part 1 provides collectors, scholars and enthusiasts with the privileged and perhaps once in a lifetime opportunity to view, study and buy unique or ultra-exclusive timepieces from this most carefully assembled of private collections.

匠·豎系列(第一部分)

一直以來,佳士得皆以呈獻環球最壯觀單一藏家的 鐘錶收藏系列而享譽全球。因此,香港佳士得滿懷 自信、興奮和期待,在本圖錄中載列出一系列矚目 的私人收藏鐘錶珍品。在2021年前,這個歷經30 多年精心打造、囊括卓越古董及當代時計的收藏系 列僅為少數人所知。在這趟漫長的收藏之旅,本場 拍賣將成為旅程的新篇章,同時向這位藏家的熱 情、堅持和毅力致敬。是次拍賣不僅函蓋了瑞士鐘 錶界頂尖品牌中最令人驚嘆的作品,還展示了數位 當代傑出獨立製錶師的獨特創作。

匠·豎系列「OAK」是「One of a Kind」的縮寫,顧名思義,本系列提供大量無語倫比且別具一格的鐘錶作品。這些鐘錶備受藏家追捧,只有品牌最尊貴的客戶才有機會獲得。本場拍賣為獨具慧眼且品味非凡的藏家迎來難能可貴的機會,將這些獨一無二的腕錶據為己有。此外,這個卓越系列中絕大部分鐘錶的品相堪稱完美,大多數為全新或幾乎未被佩戴的時計,並由其主人定期保養。

為了和更多志同道合的藏家分享匠·豎系列的傑出作品,其擁有者於2021 年12 月至2022 年6 月期間在倫敦舉辦了一次展覽,展出系列中160枚鐘錶,當中以百達翡麗的時計為主,並分別以Calatrava、計時系列、萬年曆系列、世界時間系列及稀有工藝品系列作為主題。除日內瓦百達翡麗博物館外,該場展覽展出了最多傳奇收藏家小亨利·格雷夫斯 (Henry Graves Jnr.)的時計,因而備受注目。

每兩年一度的「Only Watch」慈善拍賣會至今已舉辦了九場,而匠·豎系列的主人便是當中最活躍的買家之一,足見他對當代製錶業和慈善事業的支持和貢獻。匠·豎系列擁有不少於 10 款獨特的「Only Watch」時計,分別來自Kari Voutilainen、H. Moser、Chanel、Hublot 和 Roger Dubuis 等。

縱然每一件匠·豎系列的作品均被視為星級之作,當中仍有一些脫穎而出的珍品,包括一枚百達翡麗型號1436配黑色錶盤雙追針計時腕錶,同型號中已知的黃金版本僅59枚,只有極少數配備迷人的黑色錶盤。此外尚有曾經由法國演員Jean-Paul Belmondo 和Jack Brabham 於1959 年擁有的實璣Type XX 三曆計時腕錶;以及令人驚嘆的獨立製錶師腕錶包括Akrivia的SS AK-06 "Cadran Spéciale Bleu 和Kari Voutilainen 的不鏽鋼Only Watch GMT 6。

匠·豎系列由其持有者精心建構而成,本場拍賣為收藏家、學者和鐘錶愛好者提供欣賞、研究和購買獨特或超獨家時計的特權,實屬獨一無二、甚至是一生人一次的機會,意義不凡。

It is not often that I can claim the privilege of having been intimately connected with one of the most famous watch collections of our times. Nevertheless, I had the honour and pleasure of curating a selection of masterpieces from this collection at London's Design Museum in the spring of 2022, when, as far as I am aware, the aptly named OAK (One of A Kind) Collection became the first private watch collection to be made the subject of a major exhibition at a leading cultural institution of global renown.

The gala opening, attended by diplomats, politicians, and London Society, for which horological enthusiasts, collectors and industry notables travelled from all around the world, was a splendid occasion; that much could have been expected. Perhaps less anticipated, and maybe more gratifying, was the interest during the public days of exhibition. There was strong and regular attendance from all age groups. Seeing schoolchildren and young people gaze upon these watches in the context of a museum show was heartening as it testified to the growing realisation in among the wider public of the cultural value of watchmaking and the understanding of the exhibits, not just as collectible watches of considerable financial value, but as objects of beauty, ingenuity, and cultural significance, containing elements of the arts, history, and enaineering within their modest dimensions.

The only slight disappointment was that the nature and size of the exhibition determined less than half of the many hundreds of pieces that comprise the entire OAK collection could go on display. As those who were fortunate enough to visit the exhibition will recall, the majority of the showcases were dedicated to the work of Patek Philippe. Therefore, this catalogue, the first in a series featuring watches from the OAK collection, is interesting in that it demonstrates the breadth of the collection for the first time and offers a remarkable variety of opportunities across a range of brands and prices.

Given the collection's strength in rare Patek Philippe, pieces from the storied maker carrying the OAK provenance will inevitably attract attention few more so than two early chronograph wristwatches. The rare steel sector dial chronograph Reference 130A stands out as a fascinating example this coveted reference. This watch dates to the early 1940s, just a few years after the the company had only been saved by a consortium led by the Stern family, thitherto known as dial makers, and it is indeed a Stern dial that graces this watch, a sober, masculine masterpiece featuring concentric divisions of black enamel and the 'long' signature that was in use until the mid-1940s.

Slightly later, from 1950, is the stunning example of the historically important Ref 1436J split seconds two sub dial chronograph. Although this model is one of Patek Philippe's longest running models, introduced in 1938 and retired in 1971, total production is estimated at a mere 140 pieces, an average of fewer than five a year. Moreover, this particular watch benefits from an elegant black and gilt dial, which enhances legibility of the chronograph.

To appreciate the wristwatches made by Patek Philippe, it is necessary first to understand the variety and exigency of its pocket watches, of which this sale offers some outstanding examples. Of particular interest is the perpetual calendar watch with Guillaume balance made in 1910, and sold two years later to Mr Emmanuel Castro. The triple subdial combination days, months and date, the last combined with constant seconds, is highly unusual if not indeed unique, it is a remarkable watch dating from the golden age of complicated pocket watch manufacturing in Switzerland. Meanwhile, lovers of Patek's creative use of rare handcrafts will be pleased to see the pocket watch known as 'Mountain & Lake'

And the virtuosity of Patek Philippe's handling of enamels is also to be appreciated on the larger canvas offered by the cloisonne enamel Dome Clock known as 'Early Hot Air Balloons', which uses almost three dozen different coloured enamels to create this vivid and joyous tribute to the birth of manned

But what this catalogue really demonstrates is the omnivorous interest of the collector who does not confine himself to a single brand or type of timepiece but ranges widely over the horological landscape unafraid to cross geographical borders in his pursuit of horological beauty.

Patrick Getreide, the creator of the oak Collection, was born in France, and it is a tribute to his Gallic roots, that the first serious watch he bought, was a Cartier Tank purchased to celebrate his horse winning a race at Longchamp. This is the seed, from which the oak grew. Therefore, it is entirely fitting that this sale is very strong on classics from Cartier, especially interesting now that the French jeweller has recently reclaimed its place in the horological pantheon.

A strong French flavour is also imparted by the presentation in this catalogue of a section of fascinating Breguet watches. These range from an 18-carat gold half quarter repeating pocket watch with a secret compartment for a miniature portrait first sold to Pauline Bonaparte in 1813. As well as the Bonaparte provenance there is an extremely rare half hunter wristwatch from 1937 that was once the property of Charles Cahen d'Anvers, the founder of the Paribas bank. While in the Breguet records the Belmondo name is linked to a stylish triple Calendar chronograph from the early 1970s also offered here. Furthermore, aficionados of motorsport will be delighted to discover that the back of an historically significant Type XX carries an engraving that reads "ESSO, JB, champion du Monde, 1959", recalling its presentation to Formula One racing driver Sir Jack Brabham, to commemorate the first of three world championships that he would win.

It is possible to argue that what this selection of OAK collection watches offers is the chance to dip into a number of interesting micro-collections of families of watches: for instance, the current trend for independent watchmaking is reflected in almost a dozen timepieces from two of the most celebrated and established of contemporary makers: F.P. Journe and Kari Voutilainen. While students of recent auction history will be intrigued to see a number of lots that were originally purchased at the Onlywatch charity auction.

The collection is full of surprises not least the rare Audemars Piguet perpetual calendar wristwatch reference 5516 dating from 1957. Distinguished by the then highly innovative leap year indication just nine examples of this made were ever made, of which only six are known to the collecting community today. Similarly unexpected is the possible prototype Omega Seamaster chronograph dating from around 1970 that reflects the adventurous aesthetic tastes of the times with a light coffee coloured dial that contrasts pleasingly with crimson subdials

With watches such as these, the OAK collection offers plenty of quarry for the horological trophy hunter...with more to come. as further watches from the OAK collection are auctioned by Christie's.

得和珍貴的機會。在2022年春天,我有幸在倫敦設計博物館參 湛的琺瑯技藝。其中一座被稱為「Early Hot Air Ballons」的 與這一收藏系列的策展工作。據我所知,這個恰如其分被命名 為匠·豎系列的收藏,在當時成為了全球首個在知名文化機構舉 辦大型展覽的私人鐘錶收藏系列。

盛大的開幕吸引了外交官、政治家和倫敦協會出席;來自世界 藏並不局限於單一品牌或單一類型鐘錶,而是廣泛涉獵鐘錶界 各地的鐘錶愛好者、收藏家和行業知名人士亦蜂擁而至,造的不同領域,在追求鐘錶之美的過程中勇敢跨越地域邊界。 就一場精彩的盛會。在公眾展覽期間,不同年齡層的人士都踴 躍參與,令人喜出望外。當看到學生和年輕人在展覽中聚精會 神地欣賞這些鐘錶,便足以證明公眾日益認識到製錶的文化價 值。鐘錶不僅帶來龐大的經濟效益,而是具有美學、原創性和 開始萌芽。因此,本場拍賣會以卡地亞的經典之作為主實在非 文化意義的作品,同時蘊含豐富的藝術、歷史和工藝元素。

受著展覽性質和規模限制,整個匠·豎系列的數百件作品中只有 不到一半可以展出,稍為令人惋惜。有幸參觀展覽的人應當記 得,當時大部分展櫃均為百達翡麗的作品;而作為F·豎系列第 一部份的圖錄,這本刊物的有趣之處在於首次展現了該系列的 廣度, 收錄來自不同品牌的傑作。

鑒於百達翡麗的珍稀錶款是該系列的強項,來自這家歷史悠久 品。另有一枚1970年代初推出的三曆計時腕錶。根據寶璣紀 製錶商、帶有匠·豎系列出處的錶款難免會吸引眾人目光,其中 最引人注目的莫過於兩款早期計時腕錶。罕見的型號130A 計時 腕錶配不鏽鋼扇形錶盤,便是這一令人垂涎型號中的佼佼者。

這枚腕腕錶可追溯至 20 世紀 40 年代早期,當時公司剛被斯 登家族領導的財團接手,而斯登家族正是當時著名的錶盤製造 商。作為斯登家族的作品,這枚腕錶的錶盤沉穩而陽剛,以黑 色琺瑯刻度和一直使用到40年代中期的長簽名為特色。

緊接下來,是1950年製、具有重要歷史意義的型號1436J雙追 針計時腕錶。作為百達翡麗歷史最悠久的腕錶系列之一,儘管 它的產期由1938年開始直至1971年,其總產量估計僅為140 奇。

要懂得欣賞百達翡麗製造的腕錶,必須先 了解其懷錶的種類和稀有性。本次拍賣亦 呈獻了箇中珍品,包括一枚1910年製配 Guillaume擺輪的萬年曆懷錶,此錶於兩 年後出售予Emmanuel Castro先生。三 個輔助錶盤分別顯示星期、月份和日期, 最後一個輔助錶盤更結合跳秒功能,縱使 不是獨一無二亦十分罕見。這枚非凡時計 讓人不禁聯想起瑞士複雜懷錶製造的黃金 時代。與此同時,鍾情於百達翡麗稀有手 工藝的藏家,必定會對一枚被稱為「山與 湖」的懷錶感到十分雀躍。






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Hermès Watches

THE INDEPENDENT WATCHMAKERS

In recent years, serious international watch collectors have focused more and more upon the timepieces produced by a relatively small number of exceptionally talented watchmakers working independently in their own workshops. Free of any constraint in terms of design and production, independently made watches closely reflect the philosophies and personal watchmaking obsessions of their makers. This, coupled with their makers' truly remarkable practical, mathematical and design skills have brought independently made watches to the very forefront of contemporary collecting. Today, such timepieces are in incredibly high demand and, due to the necessarily small quantities of watches able to be produced, most of the independent watchmakers have either years-long waiting lists or have even ceased taking more orders altogether. No great collection would be complete without representative pieces from the great independent makers and naturally the OAK Collection comprises some very special examples indeed, including four of Kari Voutilainen's 'Vingt 8', one cased in titanium, one in white gold, one in platinum and one in stainless steel with spectacular red dial. Among the most desirable and coveted of contemporary independently made watch brands is Akrivia, the company founded in 2012 by the now world-renowned watchmaker Rexhep Rexhepi. The Akrivia wristwatches of the OAK Collection are truly special pieces. One, the stainless steel AK-06 was bespoke made for the owner of the collection with a gorgeous blue dial, and the example of its predecessor, the AK-01 'Tourbillon Monopoussoir' is cased in titanium. One of the most high-profile names of independent watchmaking is that of F.P. Journe, whose watches are sought the world over. Presented as part of the OAK Collection are wonderful F.P. Journe classics including the 'Octa Lune', the beautiful 'Tantalum Bleu' and the ultra-light and incredibly rare aluminum 'Centigraphe'.

In common with the vast majority of the OAK Collection watches, these independently made master-pieces are presented in exceptional condition and most accompanied by the full set of accessories.



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POCKET WATCHES

Pocket watches were the standard form of wearable timekeeper from the very earliest beginnings of the portable mechanical timepiece in the 16th century. For the first 150 years or so, watches were viewed as breathtaking and intriguing marvels that were symbolic of the high status of their owners, at a period when accurate timekeeping was largely unimportant. However, in the 18th century the quest for precision in timepieces became of prime importance, largely in order to aid maritime navigation by attempting to solve the problem of the accurate calculation of longitude which required the long-term use of a consistent timekeeper. In fact a portable timekeeper of the required accuracy by the Englishman John Harrison, was not trialled until the 1760s. Although several of the horological inventions that we know today in wristwatches were in use in the 18th century, including repeating mechanisms and the lever escapement, they were not in common everyday use. It was during the 19th century that watchmaking innovation and manufacture reached its zenith. The genius watchmaker Abraham-Louis Breguet, perhaps the greatest watchmaker of all time, invented and developed improvements to timekeeping in his watches that are still relevant today, including the tourbillon; movements built on the principles of resonance; devices for temperature compensation for watch balances; and shock absorption systems. Although it continued to be improved upon, once the timekeeping accuracy of mechanical pocket watches was brought to within small tolerances, what was to become of growing significance in watchmaking over the entire 19th century and beyond was the inclusion of complications other than basic hours and minutes. Of course complications such as moon phases, calendars and repeating had been part of watchmaking even in the early days but they were very rarely found together in one watch. Whereas in previous centuries, watchmakers had focused mainly on improving timekeeping, in the 19th century, the focus was on complication and more specifically, high complication within a single watch. The idea was taken even further in the first half of the 20th century with the notion of the 'Grande Complication' or 'Supercomplication'. 

VINTAGE WATCHES

Jean-Paul Charles Belmondo was a French actor. Initially associated with the New Wave of the 1960s, he was a major French film star for several decades from the 1960s onward. His best known credits include Breathless (1960), That Man from Rio (1964), Pierrot le Fou (1965), Borsalino (1970), Stavisky (1974) and The Professional (1981).

He was most notable for portraying police officers in action thriller films and became known for his unwillingness to appear in English-language films despite being heavily courted by Hollywood.

An undisputed box-office champion like Louis de Funès and Alain Delon of the same period, Belmondo attracted nearly 160 million spectators in his 50-year career.

Between 1969 and 1982 he played four times in the most popular films of the year in France: The Brain (1969), Fear Over the City (1975), Animal (1977), Ace of Aces (1982), being surpassed on this point only by Louis de Funès. The popularity of Jean-Paul Belmondo as actor is mainly due to the characters he interpreted in his movies, loving to highlight the virile man, fighter, but also brave and heroic, which appealed to a wide audience in France and also abroad.

During his career he was called the French counterpart of actors such as James Dean, Marlon Brando and Humphrey Bogart.

Described as an icon and national treasure of France, Belmondo was seen as an influential actor in French cinema and an important figure in shaping European cinema Euro and an im- In 1989, Belmondo won the César Award for Best Actor for his performance in Itinéraire d'un enfant gâté. He was nominated for two for two on BAFTA Awards throughout his career. In 2011 and again in 2017 he received a lifetime achievement honor: and a César d'honneur 42nd César Awards.

3 IF YOU FAIL TO PROVIDE THE RIGHT DOCUMENTS

The meaning of authentic can be found in the glossary at the end of these Conditions of Sale. The terms of the authenticity warranty are as follows:
