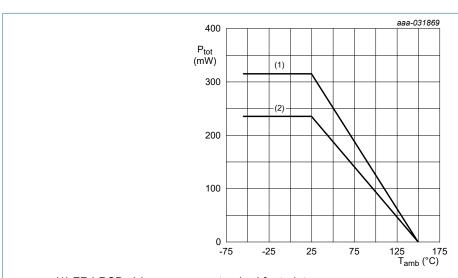

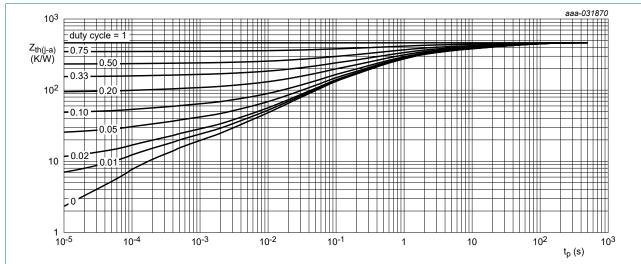

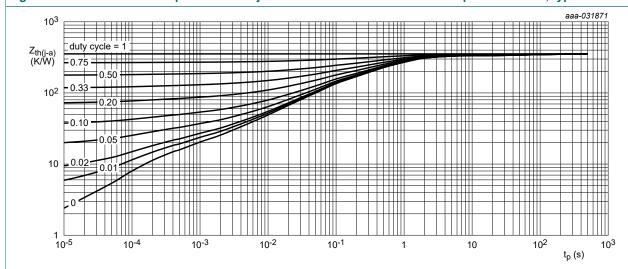

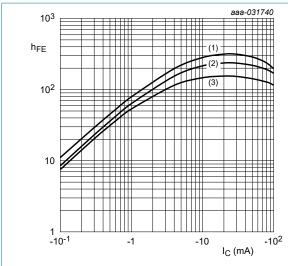

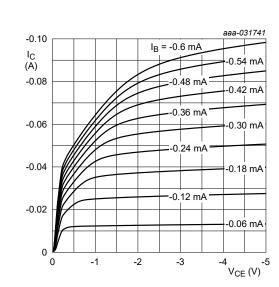

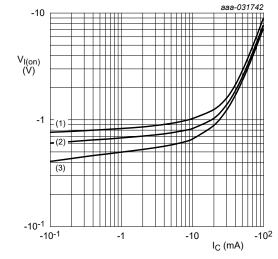

Fig. 5. NHDTA123JU-Q: Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values



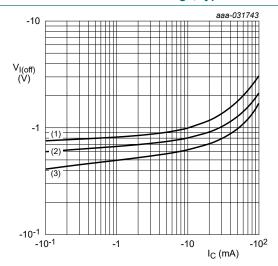

Fig. 6. NHDTA123JU-Q: On-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values

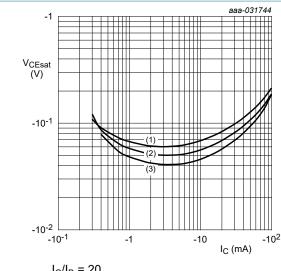

Fig. 7. NHDTA123JU-Q: Off-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



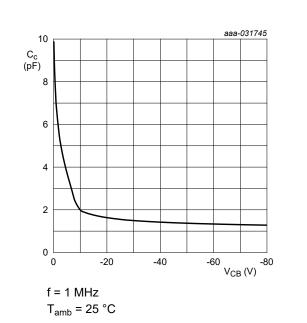

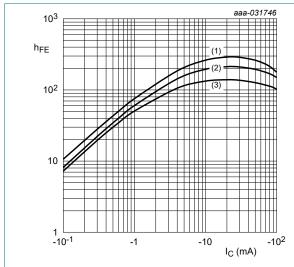

Fig. 10. NHDTA143ZU-Q: DC current gain as a function of collector current; typical values

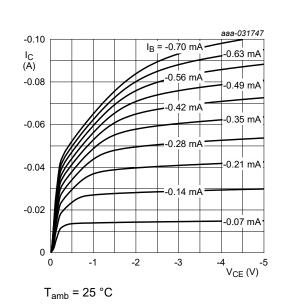
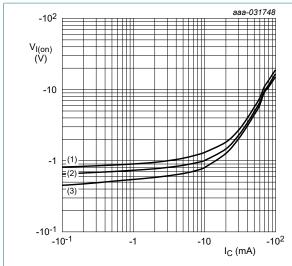


Fig. 11. NHDTA143ZU-Q: Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values



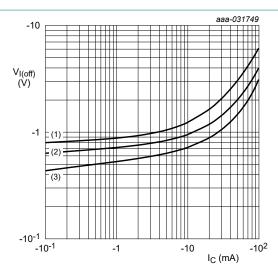

Fig. 12. NHDTA143ZU-Q: On-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



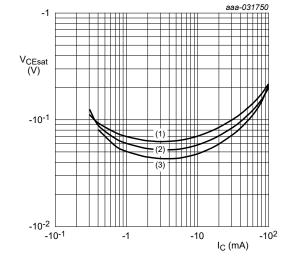

Fig. 13. NHDTA143ZU-Q: Off-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



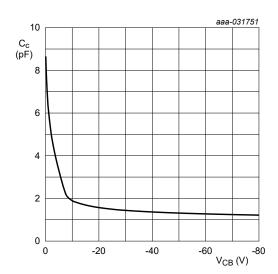

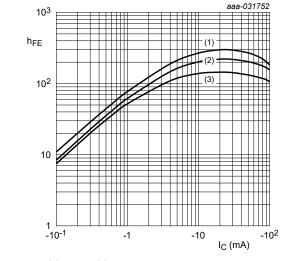

Fig. 15. NHDTA143ZU-Q: Collector capacitance as a function of collector-base voltage; typical values

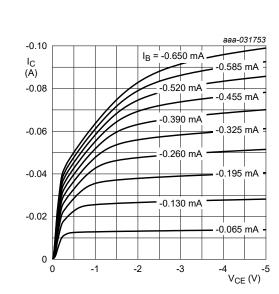

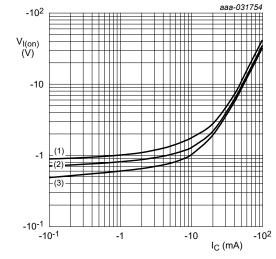

Fig. 17. NHDTA114YU-Q: Collector current as a function of collector-emitter voltage; typical values



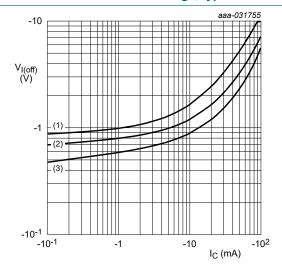

Fig. 18. NHDTA114YU-Q: On-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values



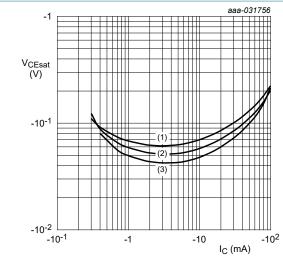

Fig. 19. NHDTA114YU-Q: Off-state input voltage as a function of collector current; typical values

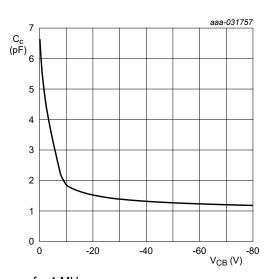

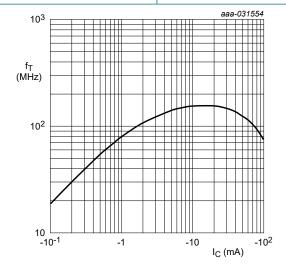
Fig. 20. NHDTA114YU-Q: Collector-emitter saturation voltage as a function of collector current; typical values

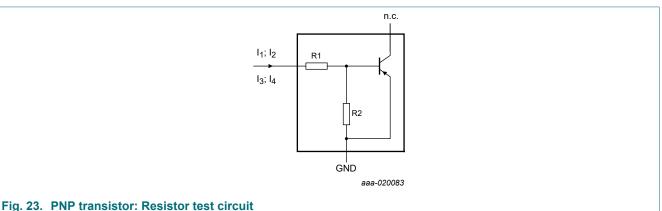

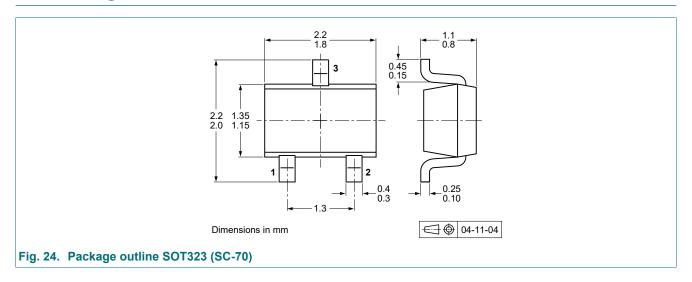

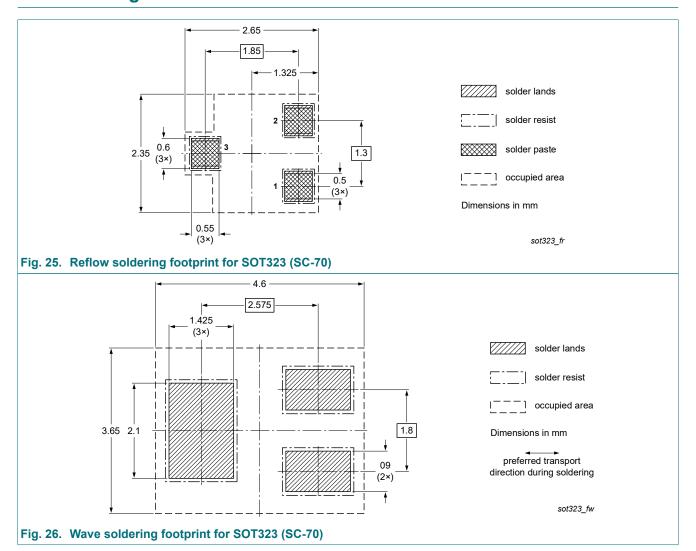
