Extremely low clamping bidirectional ESD protection diode

## 1. General description

ESD protection device in a leadless ultra small DFN1006-2 (SOD882) Surface-Mounted Device (SMD) plastic package, designed to protect automotive in-vehicle network bus lines from the damage caused by ElectroStatic Discharge (ESD) and other transients.

## 2. Features and benefits

- Reverse stand-off voltage:  $V_{RWM} = 24\text{ V}$
- Low clamping voltage: typical  $V_{CL} = 31\text{ V}$  at  $I_{pp} = 1\text{ A}$
- ESD protection up to 30 kV (IEC 61000-4-2)
- ESD protection up to 30 kV (ISO 10605;  $C = 330\text{ pF}$ ,  $R = 330\text{ }\Omega$ )
- Low capacitance:  $C_d = 10\text{ pF}$
- Qualified according to AEC-Q101 and recommended for use in automotive applications

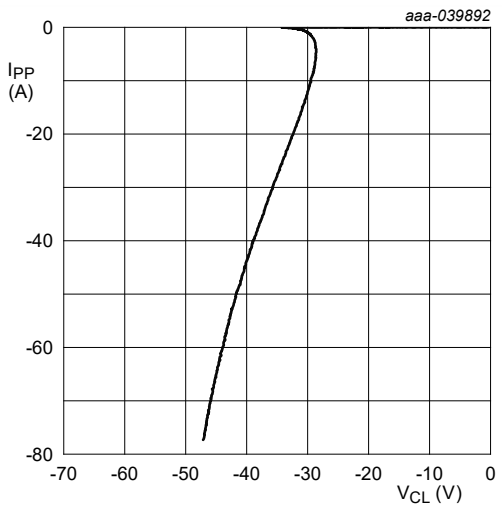

## 10. Application information

The device is designed for the protection of one automotive in-vehicle bus line, e.g. CAN (FD), from the damage caused by ESD and surge pulses.

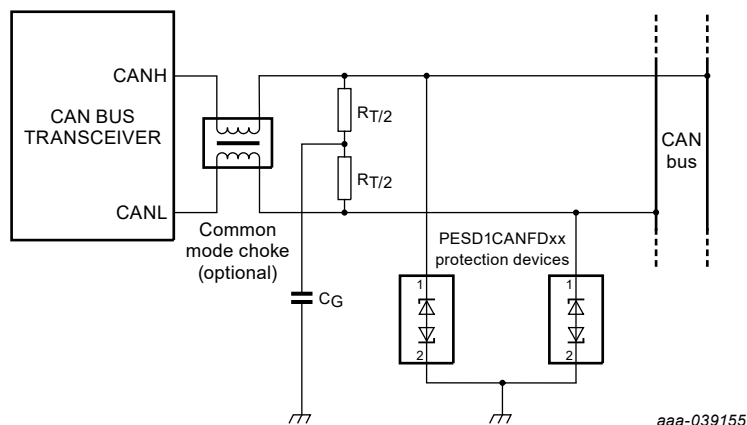


Fig. 7. Typical application: ESD protection of one automotive CAN bus line

### Circuit board layout and protection device placement

Circuit board layout is critical for the suppression of ESD, Electrical Fast Transient (EFT) and surge transients. The following guidelines are recommended:

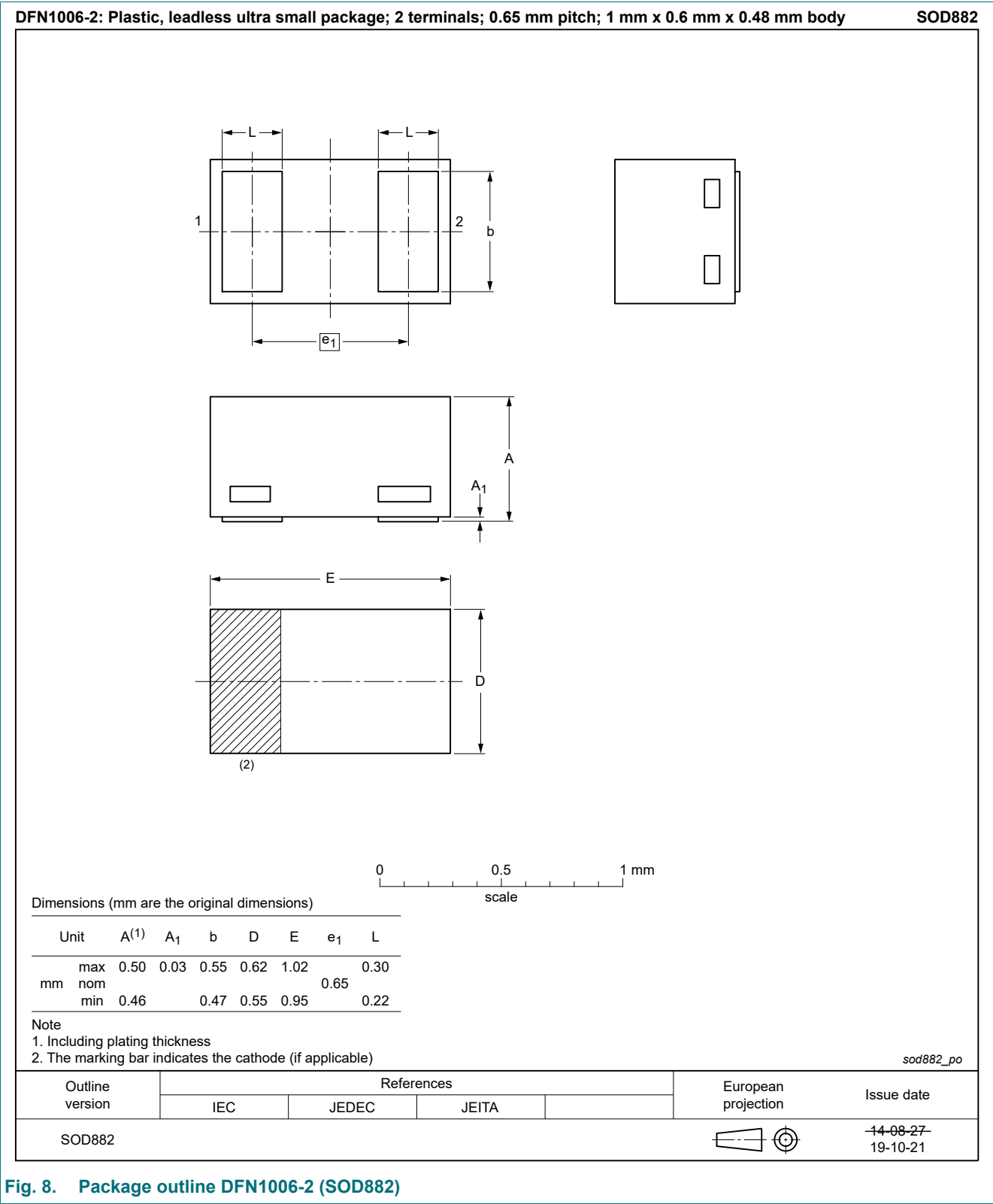
1. Place the device as close to the input terminal or connector as possible.
2. Minimize the path length between the device and the protected line.
3. Keep parallel signal paths to a minimum.
4. Avoid running protected conductors in parallel with unprotected conductors.
5. Minimize all Printed-Circuit Board (PCB) conductive loops including power and ground loops.
6. Minimize the length of the transient return path to ground.
7. Avoid using shared transient return paths to a common ground point.
8. Use ground planes whenever possible. For multilayer PCBs, use ground vias.

This product has been qualified in accordance with the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q101 - *Stress test qualification for discrete semiconductors*, and is suitable for use in automotive applications.

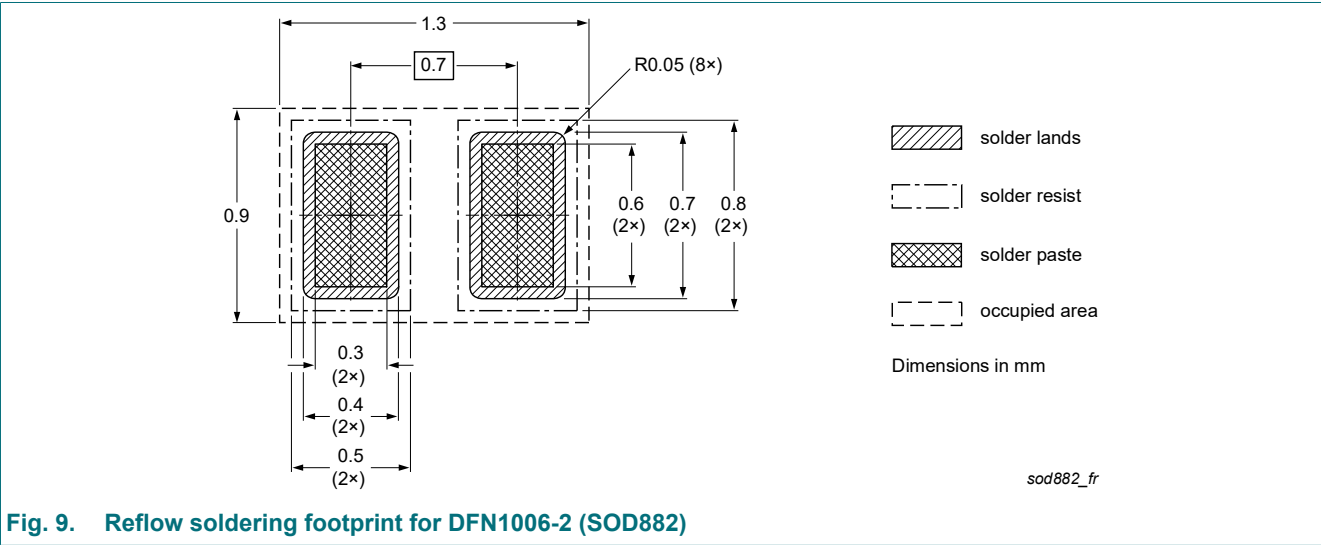


Fig. 9. Reflow soldering footprint for DFN1006-2 (SOD882)
