

REMOTE KEYPAD (RK-10)

USER'S MANUAL

CHAPTER 1 : INTRODUCTION

1-1. SUPPLIED EQUIPMENT

- 1 REMOTE KEYPAD (RK-10).
- 1 DB9 (M/F) cable (Length = 3 meters).
- 1 User's Manual.

1-2. GENERAL INFORMATION

The REMOTE KEYPAD (RK-10) is a control device for the **EASY CUT** & **EASY FADE** device. The RK-10 is specially designed to be integrated into a desktop or an electrical 2-gang wall mount box. It allows driving all the Audio & Video switching. The RK-10 is very easy to use and to install, since it only requires one cable to connect it. The RK-10 is auto-powered by the device at which it is connected and doesn't need any extra power supply.

1-3. STARTING

- ① Turn OFF your **EASY CUT** or **EASY FADE** (rear panel switch).
- ② Connect the RS-232 connector (DB9 female) of your device to the DB9 male connector of the RK-10 with the supplied DB9 cable.
- ③ Turn ON your EASY CUT or EASY FADE (rear panel switch).
- 4 Select a source with the **COMPUTER** or **VIDEO SELECTION** buttons.
- © Select the needed **EFFECT** (cut, fade or title) and press **TAKE**.

CHAPTER 2 : TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION

2-1. FRONT PANEL

EFFECT: Effect selection. This function is available with the EASY FADE only

CUT: Cut effect selection (LED turns OFF).

FADE: Fade effect selection (LED blinking).

TITLE: Title effect selection (LED ON).

AUDIO

MUTE: Allows to turn on or off the audio output (LED turns ON = no sound on output).

BREAKAWAY: Allows to permanently broadcast the same audio source whatever the video source selected.

Select a source with the VIDEO or COMPUTER SELECTION button, then press and hold

the BREAKAWAY button (LED blinking = Breakaway is active).

VOLUME (+ /-): Audio level adjustment. (Not available).

COMPUTER SELECTION: Selection of the 3 COMPUTER input sources.

1: Computer #1 source selection (Input #5).

2: Computer #2 source selection (Input #6).
3: Computer #3 source selection (Input #7).

FREEZE: Allows to freeze the displayed output.

(') : Standby. A long push (2 seconds) on this button allows to turns OFF the EASY

CUT/FADE. A short push on any button allows coming out of the standby mode.

VIDEO SELECTION: Selection of the 4 VIDEO input sources.

C.VIDEO 1: Composite source #1 selection (Input #1).

C.VIDEO 2: Composite source #2 selection (Input #2).

RGB/YUV: RGBS & YUV source selection (Input #3).

S.VIDEO: S.VIDEO source selection (Input #4).

NOTE: A long push (2 seconds) on the selected input button allows to active the **BLACK** function. A black screen is

displayed onto the output. A short push on the selected input button allows to switch off the black screen and

display back the last selected source.

TAKE: Execute the transition.

2-2. REAR PANEL

DB9 male connector: RS-232 & power connection.

5-12 Vdc: External power connector. If needed, connect an external power supply to the RK-10. This

external power supply maybe needed in case of long remote cable.

CHAPTER 3 : TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Power Supply: + 5Vdc (by the DB9 connector of the EASY CUT or EASY FADE).

Storage Temperature: $-25 \,^{\circ}\text{C} \text{ to} + 85 \,^{\circ}\text{C} (-13 \,^{\circ}\text{F to} + 185 \,^{\circ}\text{F}).$

Maximum ambient operating temperature: < 50 °C (< 104 °F).

Hygrometry: 10% to 80% (without condensation).

Dimensions: D 115 x W 117 x H 55 mm / D 4.5" x W 4.6" x H 2.16".



CHAPTER 4 : WALL MOUNTING


To install the REMOTE KEYPAD in a standard 2-gang electrical box, proceed as follow:

- ① Remove the front panel of the REMOTE KEYPAD (4 screws).
- ② Disconnect the 5-pin MC connector (screw terminal) from the REMOTE KEYPAD'S PCB and disconnect the wires from the 5-pin MC connector.
- 3 Connect the new cable on the 5-pin MC connector as shown below:
 - Connect TX on PIN 3 of the EASY CUT / FADE DB9 connector.
 - Connect RX on PIN 2 of the EASY CUT / FADE DB9 connector.
 - Connect 0V on PIN 5 of the EASY CUT / FADE DB9 connector (only 1 wire is necessary).
 - Connect 5V on PIN 8 of the EASY CUT / FADE DB9 connector.

- Connect the 5-pin MC connector to the PCB of the REMOTE KEYPAD and install the front panel into the standard 2-gang electrical box.
- ⑤ Secure the front panel with the 4 screws.
