PANDUIT Corp. has completed it's evaluation of the Fluke Networks' Personality Module PM25, and approves the use of this module with the Fluke Networks' Universal Permanent Link Adapter for the certification of installed Category 6 cabling links constructed with the $PANDUIT MINI-COM^{\mathbb{R}} TX-6^{^{TM}} T3$ Modules.

In June 2002 addendum No. 1 to TIA/EIA-568-B.2 discussing Transmission Performance Specifications for 4-pair 100 Ω Category 6 Cabling was approved. This document contained specific Category 6 de-embedded NEXT loss ranges that modular test plugs must meet. Fluke Networks responded immediately to these new specifications by developing the *PM25*. *PANDUIT* appreciates Fluke Networks' efforts to make standards compliant permanent link testing possible. *PANDUIT* has full confidence that the Fluke DSP-4000 series tester used with the DSP-LIA101 Universal Permanent Link Adapter and the Personality Module *PM25* is a standards compliant permanent link testing solution.

Fluke Networks' Personality Module PM25 will replace Fluke Networks' Personality Module PM01 as the approved module for testing of the PANDUIT MINI-COM® TX-6TM T3 Module (unshielded). The PANDUIT MINI-COM® TX-6TM T3 Shielded Module and DP6TM Patch Panel will continue to be tested using Fluke Networks' Personality Module PM01. These products will all be tested to the TIA Category 6 Permanent Link limits.

The PANDUIT MINI-COM® TX-6™ Module will continue to be tested using the DSP-LIA067 and Basic Link Limits.

Please update Fluke Networks' Website, Technical Support Personnel and Knowledge base to reflect the *PANDUIT* approved test equipment and limits.
