Comments Received that are considered “Last Call” comments

- A paragraph on Path Aggregation was missed in the last round of editing (send to mailing list?)
- Perhaps more verbage is needed to say that Class/TOS based routing is a solved problem but not widely deployed currently
 - e.g. OSPF TOS-based routing
 - IDRP features
- It is too early to talk about QoS routing for Differential Services at this time
