

Using state-of-the-art software applications, Kodak intelligent monitoring capabilities enable proactive scheduling of repairs before an "equipment down" situation occurs. We can securely monitor system performance and capacity, and diagnose problems over the Internet in real time.

Our service personnel can view and control your equipment as if they were on-site in your facility. Authentication is done through user name and password with digital certificates in a public key infrastructure. Data is encrypted using Secured Sockets Layer (SSL) or through IP-Sec VPN connectivity. An audit trail of system access and activity is maintained.


