



Change in Manufacturing Process for the Application of Frame Line Markers to Select Films

Kodak would like to announce a change in manufacturing process for the application of frame line markers to select films. Currently, the frameline marker is an ink line. Effective on a stock turnover basis, the new marker will be a small hole. This change will enable Kodak to upgrade finishing procedures, resulting in a cleaner product.
