Dear Customer:

For a variety of reasons, Eastman Kodak Company will discontinue manufacturing all Eastman Ektachrome Color Reversal Motion Picture Films (Process VNF) by year-end 2004.

VNF photoprocessing chemicals will continue to be available for your use until year-end 2005 and Finish-to-Order (FTO) beyond 2006 with lead times of several weeks. We suggest that you continue to order these materials in the quantities normally used to process your film.

Excessive ordering or inventory building may cause you to exceed the expiration date (shelf life is 2 years; cool dry) of your photoprocessing chemicals and therefore could impact the quality of your images. We want to assure you that through this transition your photoprocessing needs will be met.
