SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read through this section carefully. Following all the instructions given will guarantee reliable operation and years of gaming enjoyment from your new Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo.

Always keep these instructions handy for easy reference. Keep this instruction manual and the packaging safe. Use the original packaging when storing, shipping or transporting your Wireless Joystick/Joypad.

OPERATING SAFETY



- Never open the housing of either the joypad or joystick! This could lead to an electrical short-circuit, damage to your Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo or fire.
- Do not allow children to play with unattended with any electrical appliance. Children may not always recognize possible safety hazards.
- The Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo is intended for personal use only. It is not designed for commercial use in a heavy industry environment.

POINT OF USE

- Keep your Wireless Joystick and Joypad and all units connected to them away from moisture, dust, heat and direct sunlight. Failure to do so may lead to malfunctions.
- Place and operate all units on a stable, level and vibration-free surface to prevent damage from falling.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONDITIONS

The Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo can be operated at an ambient temperature of 32° F (0° C) to 104° F (40° C) and a relative humidity of 20% to 80% (not condensing). When switched off and disconnected, the Joystick and Joypad Combo can be stored at temperatures from -4° F (- 20 °C) to 158° F (70 °C) at a relative humidity of 20 % to 90 % (not condensing).

Do not expose the units to direct sunlight for long periods of time, as this will cause the plastic to fade and become brittle.



After transporting your Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo wait until it has assumed the ambient temperature before putting it into operation. In the event of major variations in the temperature or humidity condensation can form on the inside of the Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo which can cause an electrical short-circuit.

ELECTRO-MAGNETIC COMPATIBILITY

- When connecting the Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo observe the guidelines for electro-magnetic compatibility (EMC).
- Please use only the USB cable supplied with the Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo.
- Maintain a distance of at least three feet from sources of high frequency and magnetic interference (television sets, loudspeakers, mobile telephones, etc.), in order to avoid malfunctions and data loss.



SETTING UP AND OPERATING

HARDWARE OVERVIEW

Please take a moment to consult the Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo diagram shown below. Familiarize yourself with the function of every key element of your Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo. Controls and functions performed by your Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo will vary according to the game software you play and the setup option(s) selected.

SOFTWARE INSTALLATION

- Switch on your computer and wait until Windows has finished loading.
- 2. Insert the driver CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. The installation menu appears automatically (**Autostart**).

Note: If the automatic start does not work, the socalled "**Autorun**" function is probably deactivated. If necessary activate this function in your Device Manager by selecting the "**CD-ROM**" entry and ticking the "**Automatic notification on update**".


Manual installation without the Autorun function:

- 1) Open the "Start" menu and select "Run".
- 2) Now enter the letter for the CD-ROM drive where the CD-ROM is located, followed by a colon and the program name "auto". Example: e:auto
- 3) Click "OK" to confirm.
- 3. The program will install the Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo driver.

If your operating system is set so that the installation of drivers is only accepted if these have been signed (approved by Microsoft), a dialog appears that says "**Digital signature not found**". To install it anyway click the "**Yes**" button.

CONNECTING YOUR JOYSTICK / JOYPAD COMBO RECEIVER

- Note: You must install the driver software as described above first, if you have not already done so.
- 1. Please refer to the notes in the "**Safety and service"** section (pages 1 onwards).
- 2. Position the computer and the receiver so that they are comfortable and safe to operate.
- 3. Switch on the computer and all the peripherals connected (monitor, printer, external modem, etc.) and wait until the operating system has fully started.
- 4. Locate a free USB port on your computer.
- 5. Insert 2 AA batteries in your joystick and 2 AAA batteries in your joypad.
- 6. Connect the end of the USB cable (**0**) with the free USB socket on your computer (**2**).





7. The game device provides at the bottom two separate channels (CH.1 and CH.2). To avoid the interference when playing games please set the ID for the Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo and make sure they are using different channels.

CALIBRATING

After finishing the driver and the hardware installation, you can but don't need to calibrate and test your Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo to continue the Set-Up.

- 1. Access the Game Controller's window via
 - Start

 ⇒ Setting

 ⇒ Control Panel

 ⇒ Game Controller
- Click on General/content page to calibrate and test the devices.
- 3. If the cursor is not in the center of the area, you have to follow the calibrating process step by step.
- 4. After finishing calibrating you can play game software.

ID SETTING

This procedure is necessary only if you use also a cordless mouse or keyboard. To avoid any interference you need to give to your Wireless joystick/Joypad Combo an ID. Please follow the instruction as shown below.

Press the button under the receiver and don't let it go until you press any button of the joystick and the joypad.

• Use different channels for your joystick and the joypad.

If the ID setting has finished the LED indicator of the receiver becomes green.



If you want to cancel the setting press the button under the receiver. The green LED will turn off.

OPERATING THE WIRELESS JOYSTICK/JOYPAD COMBO

Control and functions performed by your Wirelss Joystick/Joypad Combo will vary according to the game you play and the game set up options you select. Please read your game software user's manual to determine whether your game supports these controls. With your Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo, you can play both DirectX supported force feedback and non-DirectX supported games.

CUSTOMER SERVICE

TROUBLESHOOTING

If your Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo should have problems please check if it is plugged in and properly installed. Many times problems have very simple causes. We would like to give you some tips to solve some common problems. Should these tips not help, please call us.

GENERAL GUIDANCE

The regular running of the Windows[®] programs "Defrag" and "Scandisk" can remove sources of error and increase system performance.

CHECK CONNECTIONS AND CABLES

Start with a careful visual check of all cable links.

Switch off the computer and check all cable links. If the computer is connected to any peripherals, check the cable connections of all cables. Do not arbitrarily swap the cables between various units, even if they appear to be the same. The pin assignments of the cables are likely to be different. Once you have ascertained that the power supply is not at fault and all connections are intact, switch on the computer again.

FAULTS AND POSSIBLE CAUSES

The Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo is not recognized or receives no response.

- Have you connected the cable according to the installation instructions?
- Did you connect the Wireless Joystick/Joypad Combo before installing the software? Remove the USB plug from the port and only connect it to the unit after installation.
