In the meantime, the MINOX brand has become a subsidiary of Leica and this convenient link inspired MINOX to create an unusual new edition.

THE MINOX CLASSIC CAMERA LEICA III f A LEGEND RETURNS !

The miniature format Leica III f. MINOX has faithfully recreated the original on a scale of 1:3 and the result can be seen for itself. Even at first glance, this photographic jewel, set in a fine wooden case, is a little sensation. But the inner values of the Leica III f Classic Camera also shine through. It uses the well-known MINOX 8x11 mm film and is not only fully-functional, but also

achieves excellent photographic results using the Minoxotar 1:5.6/15mm lens (3 lens elements in 3 groups). And thanks to the optional flash unit, you can even take photos with this miniature camera in poor light conditions.

In summary: Because a true classic never dies, the legendary Leica III f will be brought back to life in the MINOX format.
