The CONTAFLEX 126 is equipped with a modern CdS exposure meter, which gives through-the-lens measurement and always allows for special

factors like interchangeable lenses, close-ups and filters. The right f-stop for the preselected shutter speed is set fully automatically. It is indicated by a pointer in the finder. Red warning signals prevent wrong exposures. The diaphragm can also be

adjusted to special shooting conditions as desired. The automatic exposure control of the CONTAFLEX 126 relieves you of all complicated manipulations with shutter speed and aperture values.

Focal Plane Shutter

Symbols make it easy, even for the beginner, to set the most suitable shutter speed. No tripod is needed for any of the shutter speeds that can be set on the camera. If the lighting conditions are very poor, flash light and flash automation ensure perfect pictures.

Rangefinder

Convenient finger-tip focusing with all interchangeable lenses, even for close-ups. In the finder the displaced contours can be brought into register in the split-image indicator. Or you can adjust the blurred image in the groundglass ring to maximum sharpness.

Distance and depth-of-field are indicated on the lenses.

Flash Automation

For flash photography, the CONTAFLEX 126 does the calculating for you. Just set the distance and press the lever of the flash automation.

The right f-stop and shutter speed are set immediately, automatically. A signal in the finder warns you when the distance is too short. And for the next daylight shot the CdS exposure meter is also cut in automatically.


Changing Films

Takes mere seconds: open the back, insert 126 cartridge, and close the back. The film speed is keyed into the automatic exposure control automatically. There is no need to rewind exposed films. The window in the camera back shows whether the camera is loaded and which type of film is used.

Close-ups

With the CONTAFLEX 126 close-ups are especially simple, because the reflex finder always exactly shows the focus and the final image. Even without close-up lenses the interchangeable lenses can be focused down to very short distances (e.g. wideangle down to 12 in.). With close-up lenses on the standard lens you can even move in as close as 51/2 in. You can also get frame-filling shots of small flowers and butterflies. A host of subjects become accessible for quite extraordinary photographs.

Whether you use close-up or interchangeable lenses – you always retain the extremely simple and sure-fire camera control ensured by the CdS TTL exposure meter, the automatic diaphragm control and the two rangefinders.
