

AIAA ASTRODYNAMICS GUIDANCE AND CONTROL CONFERENCE

This specialist conference is sponsored jointly by the AIAA Technical Committees for Guidance and Control and for Astrodynamics. The conference encompasses the disciplines and technologies of the field of astrodynamics and guidance and control applied to all phases of aerospace flight from lift-off through re-entry. There probably will be one classified session.

Detailed abstracts of papers (500 to 1000 words) should be submitted in triplicate to the Program Committee by **December 20, 1963**. The first draft of tentatively accepted papers will be due on **March 20, 1964**. Papers will be accepted tentatively or rejected on the basis of the abstract. Final acceptance will be based on a review of the first draft manuscript.

Please be sure that your abstract includes the following data:

- 1) A concise statement of the problem (and possibly its genesis) or objective covered.
- 2) An indication of the scope and methods of approach coupled with a statement of what you consider to be new or a contribution of the art.
- 3) A summary of important conclusions with a statement as to whether yours is new material or whether similar results have been, or may be, published or presented elsewhere. (All papers presented at AIAA meetings will be considered for publication by AIAA; prior publication rights are accordingly reserved. Papers published previously in AIAA publications or elsewhere are not eligible for presentation at AIAA meetings.)
- 4) Provide a brief statement of the data used to substantiate your conclusions and free-hand sketches of major figures to be used.
- 5) Your name, title, company affiliation, and address, including your department or section.
- 6) A complete title of proposed paper.
