Papers for presentation at the 1964 National Telemetry Conference are solicited. The conference, which promises to be even bigger and more exciting than the 1963 NTC, will be held in Los Angeles, Calif., at the Biltmore Hotel.

Areas of Interest: Any paper covering a subject in the general field of telemetry will be considered by the Paper Selection Committee. Typical areas of interest are:

Transducers
Signal Conditioners
Multiplexing and Coding

Modulation Methods
Sync and Error Detection
Data Transmission and Reception

Data Processing
Data Storage and Recovery

Papers are desired covering the application of telemetry in the fields of:

Bio-Medicine
Spacecraft
Oceanography

Manufacturing
Geology

Zoology
Other Sciences

Military, governmental, industrial, and miscellaneous applications of telemetry are all areas of interest.

Submission: Authors should submit four copies of their papers to the Technical Program Chairman by **January 1, 1964**. All authors will be advised by January 21 whether or not their papers have been selected.

Format: Initial submission should be on double-spaced $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$ -in. sheets. Figures, drawings, and photographs do not have to be in final reproducible form, but may instead be rough sketches to indicate content. Minor corrections, changes, and updating may be accomplished after selection of papers by the Committee. Any author desiring to produce any final artwork prior to selection of his paper should write to the Technical Program Chairman for an Author's Kit. Kits will be sent to all authors whose papers are selected in January.

Classified Papers: At the present time, classified sessions are not planned. However, if sufficient interest is indicated, one may be added. Any author having a subject which must be handled as classified (no higher than Confidential) is requested to contact the Technical Program Chairman.

Presentations: Authors of selected papers will be asked to present at the conference a summary of their papers and then to answer questions from the audience. Details of the presentation will be included in the Author's Kit.

Deadline: Special attention should be given to the deadline of January 1. Plans this year include preprinting of all papers early enough to allow mailing of the proceedings to all attendees who preregister by May 15.
