

## **Preface**

The Eighth International Conference on Fundamentals of Adsorption (FOA8) was held May 23–28, 2004 at Hilton Sedona Resort and Spa, Sedona, Arizona. There were 340 colleagues and friends from 38 different countries in Sedona, Arizona at FOA8. We hope everyone went home with excellent memories and new ideas to enhance adsorption science and technology. This conference was organized under auspices of International Adsorption Society (IAS).

Following the long established tradition of FOA conferences, we collectively delivered cutting-edge scientific and technical developments in the area of adsorption. The conference received about 390 abstracts. After evaluations by the scientific committee, more than 330 papers were presented at the conference. This archival proceedings volume contains 154 papers after peer review of full manuscripts submitted at the conference.

The Keynote papers were delivered by Profs. Katsumi Kaneko (Japan), Peter Monson (USA), and Jean Rouquerol (France). The Industrial Perspectives session was very well attended and included presentations by Drs. Jun Izumi (Mitsubishi Heavy Industries Ltd.), Christian Voss (Linde A.G.) and J.M. Occhialini (Air Products and Chemicals, Inc.). The conference exhibit included latest instruments from Quantachrome Inc., Micromeritics Inc., and from Insurface group.
