### CHRONIC PAIN PATIENT SYMPOSIUM

The Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions is sponsoring a symposium entitled "A Multidisciplinary Approach to the Chronic Pain Patient," on December 3, 1980, in Baltimore, under the direction of Ann Bricker, M.S.N., and Mary Cooper, B.S.N. Topics to be addressed in this course include the coordinating role of nursing in a pain treatment center, the neurophysiology of pain transmission, pharmacological agents useful in treatment of chronic pain, psychological tests used to develop a chronic pain patient profile, common patterns of family interactions of chronic pain patients, and the development of a nursing care plan for chronic pain patients.

The Johns Hopkins University has awarded this course 0.6 continuing education units for nurses who attend the entire symposium. The fee is \$45.00.
