CONFERENCE ON CANCER NURSING RESEARCH

The second conference on cancer nursing research will be held August 17 through 19, 1981 in Seattle, Washington. The focus of the conference will be the cycle of research from

generation to application to regeneration. It is being sponsored by the American Cancer Society (Western Area Office and California, Oregon, and Washington divisions) in cooperation with the University of Washington, University of California at Los Angeles, University of California at San Francisco, University of Oregon, and the Intercollegiate Center for Nursing Education in Spokane.

The planning committee is now soliciting papers in two categories: (1) issues in cancer nursing research, and (2) research that has immediate or long-range relevance for nursing practice in assessment, methodology, intervention, or evaluation.
