

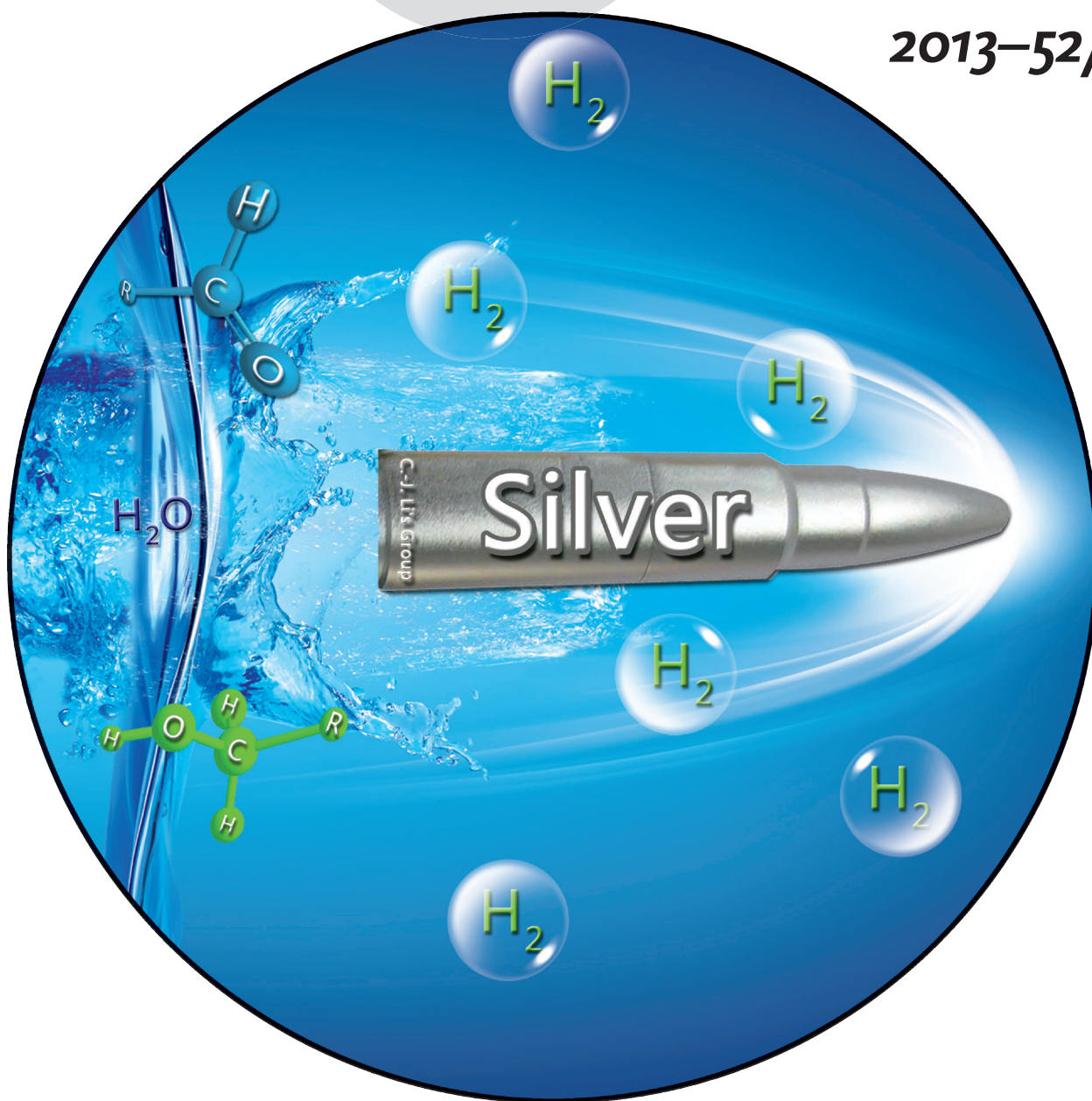

A silver-catalyzed hydrogenation ...

... of carbonyl compounds in water is reported by C.-J. Li and co-workers in their Communication on page 11871 ff. A silver complex was used to generate alcohols from a broad range of aldehydes, including aliphatic, aromatic, and heterocyclic aldehydes. This method provides a direct and efficient route to alcohols from aldehydes and opens a new avenue in silver catalysis.

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
