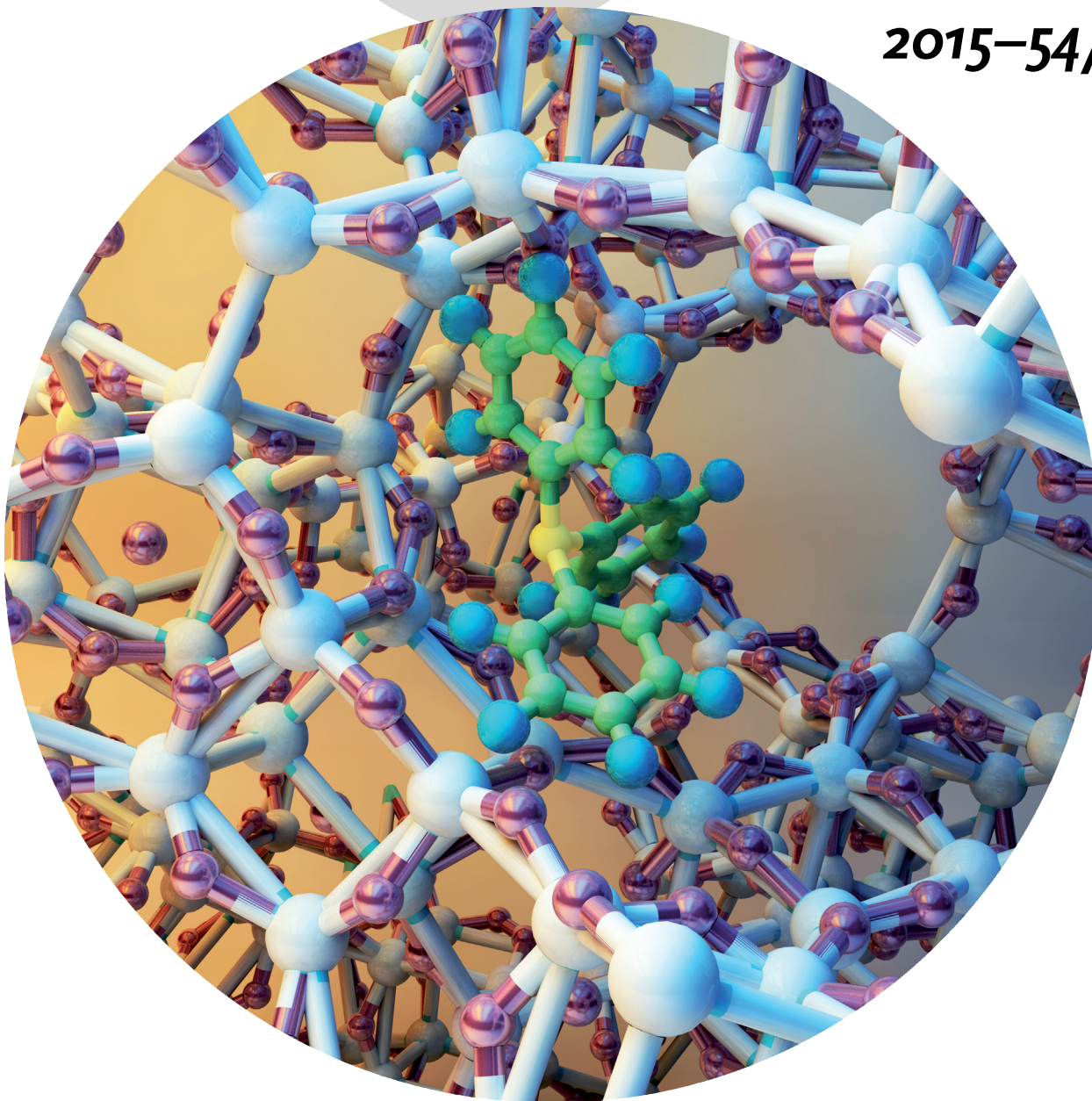

Organic sulfonium compounds ...

... are used as structure-directing agents for the synthesis of zeolites and zeolite analogues. In their Communication on page 12805 ff., R. Ryoo et al. present a zeolite with MEL structure and three other germanosilicate zeolites (ISV, ITT, and a new zeolite structure) obtained by using tributylsulfonium, triphenylsulfonium, and tri(*para*-tolyl)sulfonium. The new germanosilicate exhibits an open-framework structure with 15×12×12-membered ring pores.

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
