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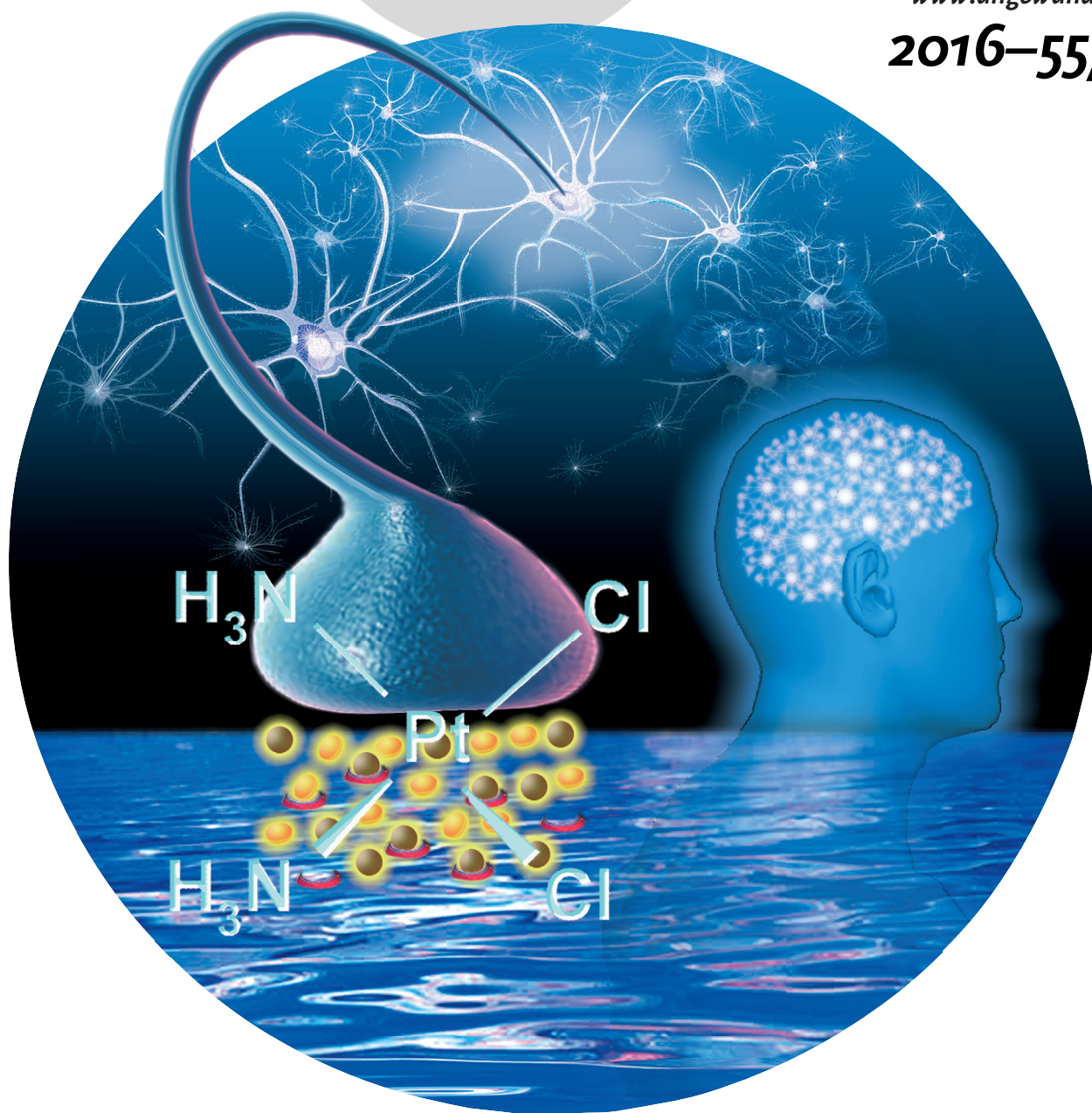
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Chemotherapy ...

... with cisplatin induces mild cognitive impairment ("chemo brain"), including memory loss, difficulties with multitasking and focusing. In their Communication on page 9041 ff., A. G. Ewing et al. use amperometry and intracellular electrochemical cytometry to show that low concentrations of cisplatin stimulate catecholamine release, whereas high concentrations inhibit this process. Cisplatin appears to regulate release during exocytosis via the fusion pore and not via the vesicle content.

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
