THEME: This conference will provide a multidisciplinary forum for review and evaluation of the current knowledge in the field of research for new drugs and vaccines and treatment of the acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS). Topics to be discussed include the design and synthesis of new anti-HIV agents, potential targets for anti-HIV drugs, biochemistry and preclinical evaluation of anti-HIV agents, clinical evaluation of new therapies against AIDS and vaccines. New information regarding the general pharmacology of new anti-HIV agents will be presented along with the latest developments in the area of immunorestorative drugs and drugs against opportunistic infections in AIDS patients.
