International Society for Antiviral Research

The International Society for Antiviral Research (ISAR) was organized and incorporated as a not for profit, tax-exempt organization in May 1987. The purpose of the Society is to aid the promotion and advancement of scientific knowledge among international investigators working in all areas of antiviral research.
