Second European Conference on Clinical Aspects of HIV Infection

March 8–9, 1990, Brussels, Belgium

The main topics of the meeting will include natural history, new diagnostic tests, clinical manifestations of HIV infection and related opportunistic infections and cancers, therapeutical approach including new perspectives on antiretroviral drugs, social, legal and ethical aspects, psychological impact in patients and health care workers, management of clinical trials. There will be a number of main lectures by eminent scientists as well as workshops, free communications, and poster sessions.

Workshops

Four workshops are being organized on topics of current clinical research. The purpose of these workshops will be to allow exchange of information among European investigators and to strengthen clinical research in the European countries.
