International Symposium on Weed and Crop Resistance to Herbicides. April 3–6, 1995 at the Palacio de Exposiciones y Congresos, Córdoba, Spain. Over the past decades, repeated use of herbicides with similar modes of action on the same field has imposed selection for increased resistance within species that formerly had been susceptible. On the other hand, in recent years considerable research in the private and public sectors has been directed toward introducing herbicide tolerance into normally susceptible crop species. The importance of research on herbicide resistance mechanisms, characterization of resistant weed biotypes, development of herbicide tolerant crops, and the management of resistant weeds and crops has become widely recognized in scientific and agricultural communities around the world.

In this regard, the European Weed Research Organization has decided to organize a multidisciplinary International Symposium on Weed and Crop Resistance to Herbicides to provide a forum for scientists to present their work and discuss these important topics. Agronomists, biochemists, ecologists, geneticists, molecular biologists, and physiologists among other specialists, are kindly invited to participate.
