

Publisher's Note

For volume 16 of *Applied Organometallic Chemistry* we are introducing two new features which will make the journal more attractive and focused: we will move to EarlyView and we will classify the articles into three sections.

EarlyView publishes each paper electronically in Wiley InterScience as soon as the authors' returned proof corrections are incorporated. As a result, the average publication time for each article will be improved by approximately 4 weeks. The articles will be published electronically in the order that our production department receives the authors' corrected proofs. Together with our other standard features on Wiley InterScience, such as automatic alerting, CrossRef for links between references and full articles, and searching, EarlyView will make the electronic usage of the journal much more attractive.

The content of *Applied Organometallic Chemistry* will be divided into three sections:

- Environment, Biology and Toxicology
- Speciation Analysis
- Materials, Nanomaterials and Synthesis

Each article will be clearly classified into one of the three categories. The article category will be indicated in the running heads in the print version and above the article title in the web version. In the print version, articles will be grouped in the table of contents according to the three sections; however, the running order of the articles within the print issue, for technical reasons, will have to be defined not by the sections, but by the order in which the articles have been published in EarlyView.

At the same time, we have also enlarged the format of the Journal to our standard size, we have modernised the cover and the layout, and we have added new editors to the editorial board. The Editor-in-Chief and the Publisher believe that these developments will make *Applied Organometallic Chemistry* even more attractive for authors and users.
