

Preface: XVth FECHEM Conference on Organometallic Chemistry, 10–15 August 2003, Zürich, Switzerland

FECHEM Conferences on Organometallic Chemistry are held biennially by the Division of Organometallic Chemistry of the Federation of European Chemical Societies.

The XVth conference, held in 2003 in Zürich, Switzerland, was organized by Heinz Berke at the Institute of Inorganic Chemistry of the University of Zürich with Franz Wild as the conference secretary. During this lively scientific event, many aspects of organometallic chemistry, from fundamentals to applications, including biomedical aspects, were covered.
