## 3rd International Symposium on Iron Transport, Storage and Metabolism

30 August to 2 September 1992, Strasbourg, France

The 3rd International Symposium on Iron Transport, Storage and Metabolism will be held in Strasbourg, France from 30 August to 2 September 1992. For the first time, it will be a Parallel Meeting to the 18th International IUPAC Symposium on the Chemistry of Natural Products. Topics will cover transport mechanisms in cells of different origins (mammalian, plant, fungal and bacterial, with emphasis on chemical, physicochemical, spectroscopic and genetic methods). Different sessions,

e.g. on siderophores, transferrin, hemoglobin, ferritin, non-heme iron will ensure that various biological systems are dealt with.
