Isotopically Labeled Drugs in Experimental Pharmacology

AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE will be held at the University of Chicago on the 7th, 8th and 9th June 1964, under the auspices of the Department of Pharmacology. Speakers from various countries have been selected to present papers describing research in which labeled drugs have served a unique role in pharmacological investigations.
