FORTHCOMING MEETINGS

The 15th International Congress of the International Society for Chronobiology will take place in conjunction with a meeting of the International Society for Research on Civilization Diseases and the Environment in Minneapolis, Minnesota, U.S.A., 13–18 September 1981. The meeting will consist of three days of poster sessions with short presentations and discussions covering all areas of chronobiology—the study of biologic rhythms and trends with maturation and aging—and a one-day workshop on special areas, including the methodology of chronobiology.
