Although opioids were the first to be recognized as Endogenous Drugs, the concept for the existence of endocoids has been suggested throughout the modern history of medicine. This symposium will provide state-of-the-art reviews on concepts and methodology to identify endocoids as well as distribution, release, inactivity, physiological/pathological roles, and drug development potentials of specific drug-like substances isolated from animal tissues.
