PERSPECTIVES IN RADIOPROTECTION

A two-day symposium will be held in Bethesda, Maryland, on 13–14 March, 1987 to consider the current status of chemical protection against ionizing radiation and provide the opportunity for extensive discussion of new approaches to the problem. The symposium will follow the 2nd Conference on Anticarcinogenesis and Radiation Protection to be held at the National Bureau of Standards, Gaithersburg, Maryland on 9–12 March.

The format of PERSPECTIVES IN RADIOPROTECTION will be mainly panel discussions.
