### INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM/WORKSHOP ON DOPING IN SPORTS

Seoul, Korea,  
10–14 September 1988

Jointly Organized by The International Olympic Committee Medical Commission and The Korea  
Advanced Institute of Science and Technology, Doping Control Center

The purpose of the Symposium is to bring together world sports scientists to exchange information and ideas on recent advances being made, to establish contacts for future cooperation or recommend future actions on various aspects of doping control in sports.

The purpose of the Workshop is to learn the most advanced methodology and techniques in sample preparation, analytical instrument handling and data interpretation in doping tests.

#### *Scientific programme*

The Symposium/Workshop will be divided into two events:

(1) *Symposium: one day.* Historical review of doping control movement; doping in sports; physician's viewpoint, athlete's viewpoint, coach's viewpoint; I.O.C., I.F., N.O.C. position of doping; technique of doping test; medical case reports on side effects of doping agents; laboratory tour.

(2) *Workshop: four days.* Systematic analysis of doping agents; sample preparation and analytical instruments operation to analyze IOC banned substances (stimulants, narcotics,  $\beta$ -blockers, diuretics, steroids and masking agents); data interpretation.

During the 4-day Workshop, not more than 30 people will be allowed to participate. Four people will be assigned to one instrument with two instructors.
