XIIIth EUROPEAN SYMPOSIUM ON HORMONES AND CELL REGULATION

Sainte-Odile (near Strasbourg), France, 26–29 September 1988

Sponsored by “Institut National de la Santé et de la Recherche Médicale” (INSERM)

The aim of this Symposium is to present reviews of recent advances in general lectures and communications of recent unpublished results in posters, both being analyzed at length in general discussions. Main topics of the 1988 conference are Regulation of gene expression, Growth and differentiation, Guanine nucleotide binding proteins, Protein phosphorylation, Hormone receptors, Insulin action.
