The Steroid Reference Collection supplies samples of steroids and related compounds for use in clinical and biochemical studies, such as the identification of novel metabolites, and the development and standardization of micro-assay and separation techniques. Over 4000 different compounds are available, many of them donated by eminent scientists, especially upon retirement. Financial support from the U.K. Medical Research Council and the U.S. National Institutes of Health, which has enabled the Collection to operate since 1954, is unfortunately coming to an end, but Dr Alfred Bader has kindly agreed to take charge of the samples as part of the Alfred Bader Library of Rare Chemicals.

There will be a uniform handling charge of £20 sterling for each sample supplied.
