RADIOPHARMACOKINETICS AND DOSIMETRY—A COURSE FOR THE NON-SPECIALIST

Berkeley, CA, U.S.A., 30 March-1 April 1995

Presented by: International Association of Radiopharmacology and Office of Continuing Education, University of Massachusetts Medical Center, Worcester, MA.

This course offers a unique combination of both pharmacokinetics and dosimetry with the emphasis directed towards practitioners of radiopharmaceutical design and others employing radioactivity. A similar 3 day course has been successfully offered for the past 2 years at the University of Massachusetts Medical Center. To be covered the first day is a review of the basic principles of pharmacokinetics and an introduction to the concepts of compartmental and non-compartmental analysis. The second day will cover computer modeling and hands-on analysis of data sets using software modeling programs such as SAAM. The final day will cover absorbed radiation dose calculations which will include the basics of MIRD dosimetry, data collection methods, data analysis and planning for internal radionuclide therapy.
