Revision of Enzyme Nomenclature: Listing Enzymes

A new edition of Enzyme Nomenclature is being prepared. During preparation it has become clear that some of the references in the present (1978) edition and its four supplements [Eur. J. Biochem. 104, 1-4 (1980); 116, 423-435 (1981); 125, 1-13 (1982); 131, 461-472 (1983)] are incorrect. Unfortunately it is impracticable to check all 4000 references to ensure that each does indeed refer to the enzyme indicated. Nonetheless, most of the errors are probably known to biochemists interested in the particular enzymes in whose listing the errors occur, and it would also be relatively easy for individual biochemists to check whether the entries for the enzymes of which they have specialist knowledge are correct.
