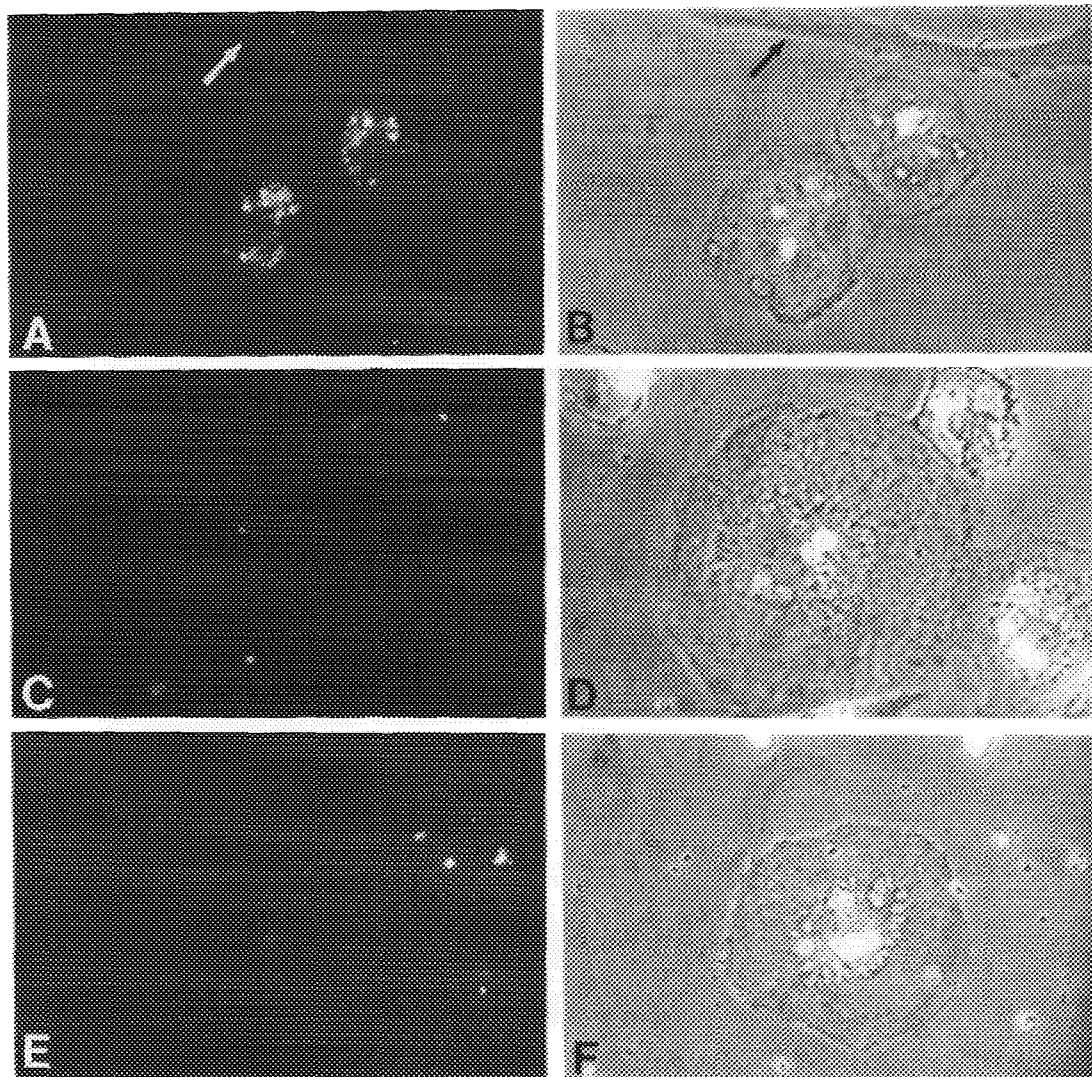


Figure 6. Fluorescent and phase contrast images of osteoclasts. (A) Osteoclasts treated with $2\mu\text{M}$ $17\beta\text{-E}_2\text{-BSA-FITC}$ for 40 minutes; fluorescence was centrally located and the adjacent fibroblast (arrow) did not stain. (B) Phase contrast of A; arrow points to fibroblast. (C) Osteoclast incubated with $2\mu\text{M}$ $17\beta\text{-E}_2\text{-BSA-FITC}$ and $1\mu\text{M}$ $17\beta\text{-estradiol}$ to block staining resulted in substantially less fluorescence. (D) Phase contrast of C. (E) Osteoclast incubated in $0.625\mu\text{M}$ BSA-FITC for 40 minutes as the control. Note that there were barely detectable amounts of fluorescence. (F) Phase contrast of E (460x).

Figure 6 was damaged during printing. For the reader's convenience Fig. 6 and its legend are shown here.
