On page 999, under Materials and Methods, the authors purchased the oligo(dT)-primed human liver cDNA library from Stratagene to obtain XDH 54 and 69 clones. Recently, Stratagene reported that this library was not human (Stratagene, Vol. 7, 1994). The correct 3'-fragment sequence of human XDH cDNA that was obtained from RT-PCR on human liver total RNA and confirmed by exon sequences of human genomic XDH sequence has been submitted to GenBank under Accession No. U06117.
