## **ERRATUM**

Volume 213, Number 2 (1995), "A Simple Molecular Assay for the  $C^{1166}$  Variant of the Angiotensin II Type 1 Receptor Gene," by Aroon D. Hingorani and Morris J. Brown, pages 725–729: The authors stated that the  $A^{1166} \rightarrow C$  polymorphism in the angiotensin II type 1 receptor gene fails to create or abolish a restriction enzyme cutting site. It has since come to the authors' attention that the  $C^{1166}$  variant creates a restriction site for the endonuclease DdeI (a method described in Katsuya *et al.*, Lancet, **345**, 1600–1603, 1995). A PCR/RFLP-based genotyping method using this enzyme can thus be used as an alternative for the rapid detection of this polymorphism. The authors apologise for this error.
