


FIG. 3. Mitogenic activity of FGF-2 in the absence (A) and presence (B) of added heparin. Heparin (■), *N*-sulfoacharan sulfate (▲), syndecan-1 (●), and acharan sulfate (△) were used at increasing concentrations and the incorporation of $[^3\text{H}]$ -thymidine into DNA by F32 cells was measured. The heparin (alone) and FGF-2 (alone) controls gave ~ 750 cpm.
