VOLUME CODING FOR BBA-BIOMEMBRANES

BBA is published according to a volume-numbering scheme that embraces all sections of the journal: for 1969 the scheme—covering the volumes 171–195—is to be found on the inside cover of this issue. The seven individual sections are distinguished by a colour code. In addition to the colour code each section is given its own sequential volume numbers. This system runs parallel to the overall BBA scheme: for the BIOMEMBRANES section the correspondence is indicated in the Table below.
