REFERENCES

As from the present date Elsevier Publishing Company, publisher of *Biochimica et Biophysica Acta*, intends to implement the recommendations of the Commission of Editors of Biochemical Journals of the International Union of Biochemists concerning references.

The recommended style is as follows:

Pispa, J.P. and Buchanan, F.M. (1971) *Biochim. Biophys. Acta* 247, 181–184

It should be noted that first and last pages are cited; this will be optional for papers published during 1972, but will become mandatory in 1973.

In the reference list, titles of journals should be abbreviated in accordance with the Chemical Abstracts Service (American Chemical Society) system.

Examples of the style to be used in the reference list for references to books are:

Dixon, M. and Webb, E.C. (1964) *Enzymes*, 2nd edn, p. 565, Longmans Green and Co., London

Grant, J.K. (1969) in *Essays in Biochemistry* (Campbell, P.N. and Greville, G.D., eds), Vol. 5, pp. 1–58, Academic Press, London and New York

Contrary to paragraph 5, p. 6, of “Information to Contributors” of *Biochimica et Biophysica Acta*, unpublished work of one or more of the authors should not be listed under References, but should be mentioned in the text as follows:
