The Elsevier Publishing Company, publisher of *Biochimica et Biophysica Acta* intends to implement the recommendations of the Commission of Editors of Biochemical Journals of the International Union of Biochemistry, concerning presentation of reference lists.

The recommended style for citation of journals¹ (abbreviated according to Chemical Abstracts), books² and multi-author books³ is given in the following example:

- 3 Brachet, J. (1967) in *Comprehensive Biochemistry* (Florkin, M. and Stotz eds), Vol. 28, pp. 23–54, Elsevier, Amsterdam

References are cited in the text by number, and the reference list should be in the order of citation, not in alphabetical order.

First and last page numbers are to be included.

Unpublished work should not be listed in the References but mentioned in the text as follows: (Spector, R. and Glimcher, J., unpublished).
