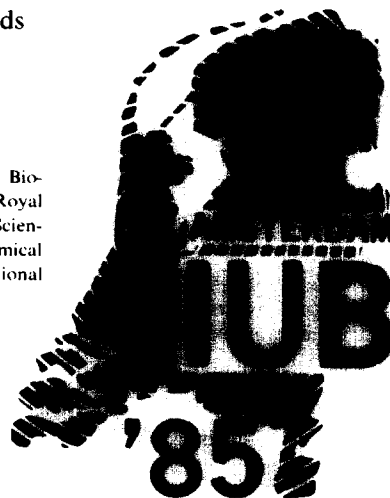

SOCIAL EVENTS

The social programme will include, amongst other events, an informal get-together, a reception offered by the Minister of Education and Science and the Burgomaster and Aldermen of Amsterdam, a concert by the "Concertgebouw Orchestra" and a farewell evening "In touch with the Dutch". A choice of daily excursions will be offered to participants' companions.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

The scientific programme will include a daily plenary lecture, symposia with invited speakers, colloquia and poster sessions. The colloquium speakers will be selected from the contributors to the poster sessions. Symposia and colloquia will cover topics within the following areas:

1. The genome: structural organization and replication
2. Gene expression and transcriptional controls
3. Nucleic acid-protein interactions, including protein synthesis
4. Protein structure and function, including enzymology
5. Metabolic regulation
6. Membrane structure and functions
7. Bioenergetics
8. Cellular growth, differentiation and transformation
9. Hormones
10. Molecular and cellular immunology
11. Molecular mechanisms of disease
12. Applied biochemistry, including biotechnology, biochemistry in agriculture, environmental biochemistry, and biological production of industrial chemicals and fuels.
