## PUBLISHERS' NOTE

The BBA Single Reprint Service has been in operation now for two years. Although the interest which has been shown in this new Service to readers and authors is by no means discouraging, the Publishers are under the impression that it is not yet generally known to all readers of Biochimica et Biophysica Acta. Therefore it would seem appropriate to explain once more, in brief, how the Service operates.

Of every article that has appeared in BBA since January 1, 1965, an extra stock of reprints has been prepared and stored. Any reader of BBA can obtain a high quality reprint from this Service by sending in a Coupon giving the code-number of the required article. Within 24 hours after receipt of the Coupon the reprint is despatched by airmail.

About 6000 Coupons have so far been sold to scientists all over the world and an increasing number of readers compose their own "tailor-made" BBA by ordering reprints of those articles that fall within their individual fields of interest.

It is the Publishers' intention to continue the BBA Single Reprint Service—which was originally set up on an experimental basis—for at least another two years. In view of this we should like to take this opportunity of introducing this system to those who have not yet made use of it. If, therefore, you would like examine the Service for yourself, order a few Coupons now using the order slips opposite. The Coupons are available at the following prices:
