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NEW VOLUME CODING FOR BBA-ENZYMOLOGY

BBA is published according to a volume-numbering scheme that embraces all sections of the journal: for 1968 the scheme—covering the volumes 150-170— is to be found on the inside cover of this issue. The seven individual sections are distinguished by a colour code, and a series number has hitherto been inserted on the spine.

The overall volume-numbering system and colour code are to be maintained; however, instead of the series number, each section is to be given its own sequential volume numbers, these being assigned in retrospect to the volumes already published in that section. This system will run parallel to the overall BBA scheme: for the ENZYMOLOGY section the correspondence indicated in the Table below. This issue is therefore BIOCHIMICA ET BIOPHYSICA ACTA, Vol. 151/3 or BBA-ENZYMOLOGY E22/3.
