Twelfth Miles International Symposium

“Polypeptide Hormones”

This symposium will address itself to recent developments in research on mammalian polypeptides that exhibit hormonal properties. Highlights of current laboratory and clinical studies of their biological and chemical synthesis, transport, receptors, and cellular response will be presented. Several sessions devoted to hormones according to their specific site of secretion (e.g., hypothalamus, thymus) are also included. The topics to be discussed reflect the current high level of interest regarding polypeptide hormones and will appeal to many investigators involved in cell biology, endocrinology, and pharmacology.
