First World Congress of Cellular and Molecular Biology Paris–Versailles, Palais des Congrès, 1 to 7 September 1991

The 1st World Congress of Cellular and Molecular Biology, organized by the consensus of the editors of the journal *Cellular and Molecular Biology* together with several outstanding personalities of the scientific world, will be the first manifestation of the new integrative and interdisciplinary science: *Cellular and Molecular Biology*. The aim is to realize structural progress in the actual development of the life sciences.

It will include about 40 symposia concerning the most promising themes in the field of cellular and molecular biology, directed by moderators, presenting the themes, together with 5 to 6 co-moderators, presenting the sub-themes.
