I am delighted to announce the appointment of Professor Astrid Gräslund of the University of Stockholm, Sweden, as 'Reviews Editor' of *Biophysical Chemistry*. On behalf of the Editorial Board I warmly welcome her, and take this opportunity to assure her of our full support and encouragement in this important task.

Astrid's appointment reflects the growing importance of reviews to the development of the journal. The inclusion of reviews has been a much appreciated addition to *Biophysical Chemistry* in recent years. Through them, acknowledged experts have brought contemporary perspectives on important areas of biophysical chemistry to the journal, and its audience. Such reviews have generated much interest and stimulated further work. In the future, we plan to publish at least one review per volume, possibly more.

The journal was until recently, contained in three volumes, but a growing popularity with author and reader alike will see publication into five volumes in 1995, and probably six volumes in 1996.
