

Publisher's Note

We are pleased to announce a program of new features for *Biophysical Chemistry (BPC)*, all aimed at meeting the increasing demands of authors and readers. We want BPC to be the key resource for obtaining the most up to date information in the field and the preferred journal for publication of the best work. Aspects such as rapid publication and access to information, use of new technology and wide(r) distribution are becoming increasingly important for scientists. The initiatives listed below take these considerations into account:

Electronic processing: all aspects of the production process of BPC are dealt with in electronic format. This makes it more important to deliver the final versions of papers on a disk, accompanying the hardcopy text. Figures will still be dealt with in the conventional way for the immediate future.

BPC Letters section: publication times of about 3 months: Upon an author's request, the Editor decides whether the paper qualifies for this type of publication. Criteria used are novelty of research, a size limitation of 10 manuscript pages (text and tables/figures together) and the paper must be submitted on disk. There will be no proofs.

Free copies to authors: Until further notice, corresponding authors will receive, free of charge, one copy of the issue in which their contribution is published. In addition to this, they can provide *the names of up to five researchers and librarian* to which Elsevier will subsequently send a complimentary copy of the issue.

Colour pictures and other supplementary material on WWW: Authors may submit colour pictures and other supplementary material along with their paper, which will be put at the BPC HomePage at <http://www.elsevier.nl/locate/bpc>.

Alerting service via e-mail. A free electronic alerting service has been established which will deliver the table of contents of BPC issues approximately 3–4 weeks before publication. To subscribe to this service, send a message to bpc-e@elsevier.nl with the following text in the subject line: `subscribe bpc-c`.

Printed colour. BPC offers a special reduced rate for publishing two or more printed colour pages. These prices will be communicated upon individual request.

Personal subscription possibility.

A personal subscription has been established for people at institutes that already hold an institutional subscription. The 1996 personal subscription price is Dfl. 275. Payment is possible by Credit-Card only. A limited number of copies is available.
